URAC’s International Policy does not permit Independent Review Organizations to offshore any of the functions under the scope of URAC’s Independent Review Organization Accreditation. Additionally, international companies are not eligible to pursue URAC’s Independent Review Organization Accreditation.

“By applying for and receiving the Independent Review Organization Accreditation, IMX Medical Management Services has demonstrated a commitment to quality health care,” said Alan P.Spielman, URAC president and CEO. “Quality health care is crucial to our nation’s welfare and it is important to have organizations that are willing to measure themselves against national standards.”
